

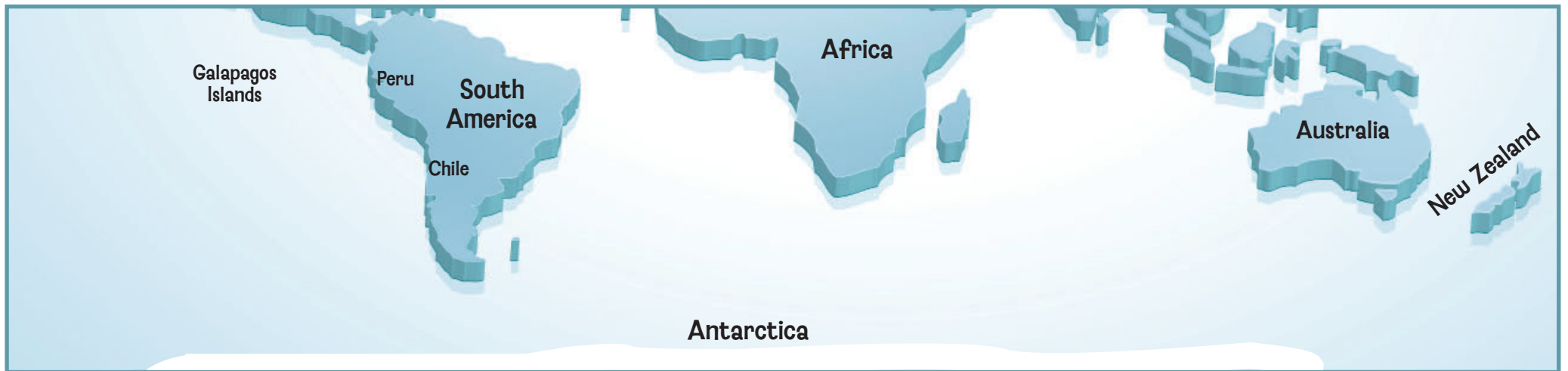



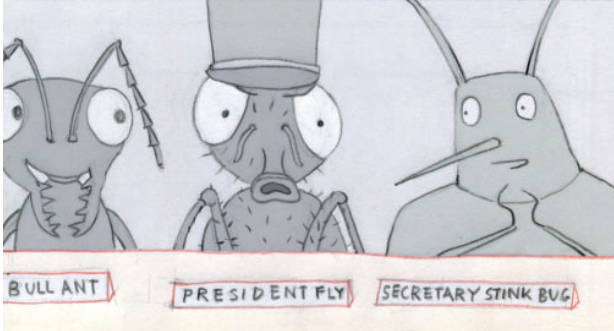
Draw a diagram of any penguin of your choosing.
