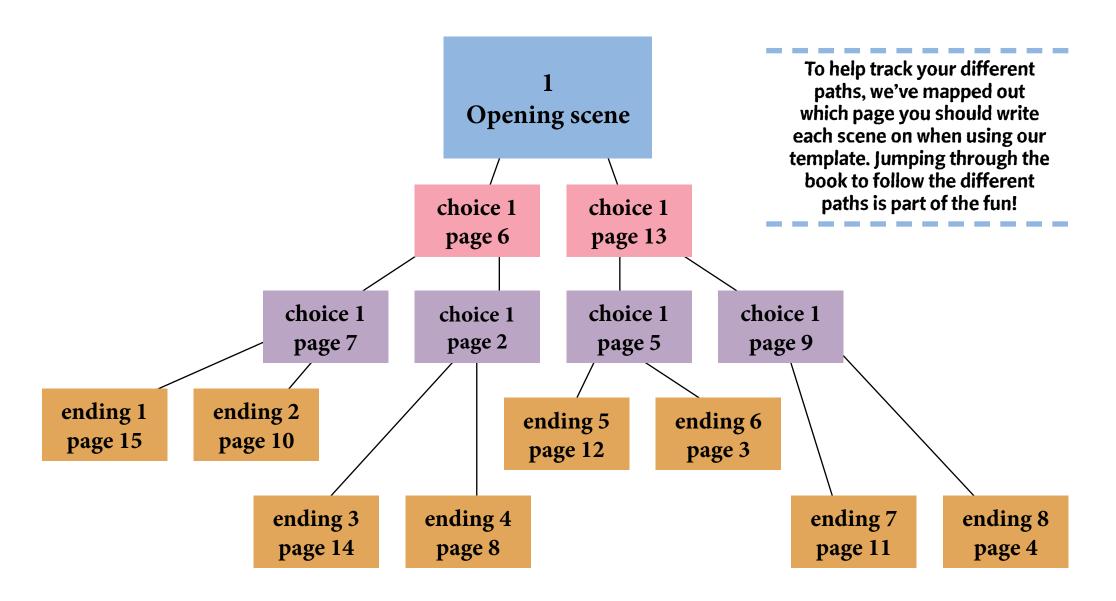

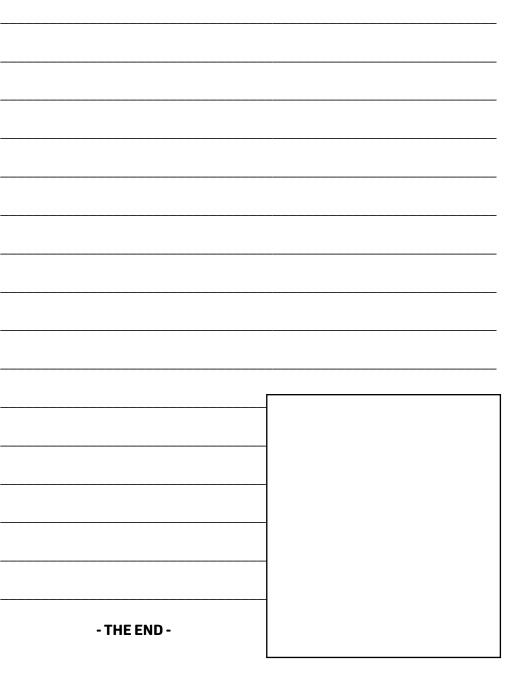
To create this type of story as an author, you will need to brainstorm ideas for a range of different options and adventures, including multiple endings. Each direction can take different twists and turns and incorporate a range of feelings and experiences, such as a funny situation, a scary encounter or a shocking ending.

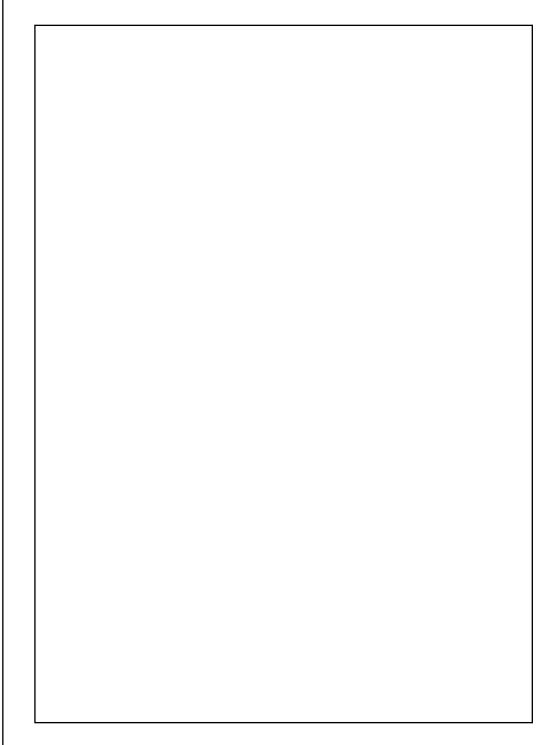
You should always start with a strong opening scene for your characters that invites the reader to feel invested in their journey. The end of the scene should bring them to a situation where two different choices can be made. From there, you will need to continue branching out your story with different choices, writing scenes and endings for each.

Planning Map



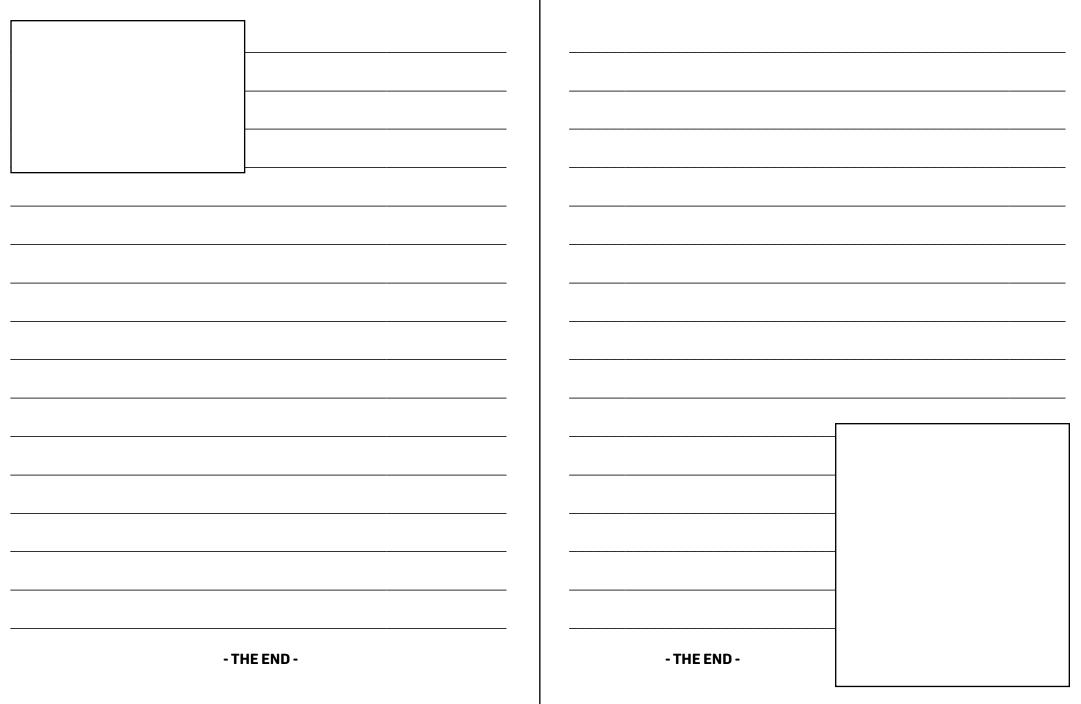
